PARENT CAMPER AGREEMENT

Camp Highlander is hereby granted permission to use any individual or group photographs taken at camp showing my child in camp activities for publicity and brochure purposes.

I understand that no medical treatment can be performed on my child without the required Camp Highlander Medical Form on file. In the event of an emergency, I will be notified. However, if I cannot be reached, I hereby give my permission to the physician selected by Camp Highlander to hospitalize, secure treatment, order injection, anesthesia, and surgery for my child as named above.

I understand that there are a number of inherent risks involved in summer camp activities. I, my spouse and child agree to assume those risks and we each release and hold Camp Highlander, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers and agents harmless from, and waive any claim against the Camp as to, any injury that may occur to my child while attending Camp Highlander.

Camp Highlander directors reserve the right to place each camper in the cabin we feel is best. While careful consideration is given to requests, the final decision rests with the directors. I agree to support the final decision of the directors in their cabin placement of my child.

Enclosed is a check or credit card number for a \$500.00 deposit (of which \$250.00 is non-refundable) that will be deducted from camp tuition. I agree to pay the remaining balance in full by April 1, 2009. All applicants after April 1, 2009, agree to pay tuition in full upon application. All camp fees are refundable except \$250.00 of the deposit before April 1, 2009, and cancellations MUST be in writing to the camp office before April 1, 2009. If I cancel after April 1, 2009, I understand that all camp tuition, minus the \$250.00, will be credited toward the summer of 2010 tuition for my child. - Camp Highlander will take 10% off of the tuition price for campers that register for multiple sessions.
- A sibling credit of \$150 per camper is given to the second, third and fourth child from the same family.

TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND REGISTRATION

A deposit of \$500 is due with the application, and all remaining camp fees are due on April 1, 2009. Applications must be filled out completely and mailed with the deposit. Camp Highlander reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any applicant who in our judgment will neither benefit from nor contribute to the camp experience.

WAITING LIST POLICY

Applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis. If we receive your application after we have reached capacity, you will be notified and your child's name will be placed on a waiting list. If a space does not become available, your deposit will be refunded.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If a cancellation is necessary, payments, less a \$250 administrative fee, are refundable if **written notice** is received prior to April 1. No refund will be made for cancellations after April 1. Any cancellation after April 1 will provide credit towards the following summer tuition for your camper. There is NO refund for late arrival, early departure or disciplinary dismissal from camp.

MEDICAL MATTERS

At least two registered nurses are on duty on camp premises 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Their services are rendered free of charge in our camp health hut. A doctor is always available 4 miles away, and a modern, complete hospital is located in Hendersonville 15 miles away Margaret Pardee Hospital.

Should a camper require outside medical services including doctor, hospital services, orthodontist, and medicine due to illness, all bills will be paid by your credit card or billed to you.

Every camper must have a current, completed Medical Form, Physician's Exam, Immunization Record and Insurance Card on file in the Health Hut 30 days prior to the start of the session.

CABIN PLACEMENT

One of the benefits of a camp experience involves meeting and making new friends from different places, Camp Highlander encourages campers to attend without concern for hometown friends. We will carefully consider ONE mutual request for campers of similar age and grade.



CAMPER ACCOUNTS

We suggest a weekly allowance of \$25.00 per camper for camp store items, off-camp trips and spending money. A ledger sheet will be kept detailing your child's expenses and any unused balance will be mailed to you at the end of camp. The Camp Highlander Trading Post will be open on opening and closing days at camp.

MAIL AND PHONE

Mail should be sent to 42 Dalton Road, Mills River, NC 28759. It is helpful to include your camper's cabin number on the envelope. We encourage you to email your camper through the CampMinder page on our website with your login and password. Emails are printed daily for your camper.

You can call the camp office anytime during camp, and we will assist you in any way possible. During the summer, our office is open from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm. If you receive an answering machine, please leave a message and someone will call you back as soon as possible.

We are here to talk to you and will work with you to insure that your child has a positive and successful experience at camp. **We do not allow phone calls to campers, nor are campers allowed to call home to parents.** We have found that parental phone calls interfere with the camper's adjustment to camp life and their daily schedule.

VISITATION

Attending camp provides a unique opportunity for campers to gain independence and self-reliance. Therefore, we discourage visitation from parents and family members. However, if you wish to visit your child, visitation may occur on Sundays at camp. Campers can leave with their parents **ONLY**. Campers will not be allowed to leave with friends or their parents friends.

NO PACKAGE POLICY

In the interest of our environment and controlling waste, Camp Highlander has a no package policy. **Any packages received will be returned to the sender.** Please inform family and friends and remind them not to send packages. If your child forgets to pack an important item, you may send it after you have notified the office of the need. The package will be opened and delivered to your camper.

LUGGAGE

Luggage may be shipped UPS or FedEx which delivers directly to camp. Please send luggage a week to ten days prior to your child's arrival so that it will be at camp on time. At the end of the session, the luggage will be shipped back to you, and we will invoice you for the shipping charges. You may also choose to use the luggage service provided by Camp Highlander from Boca Raton. Contact the camp office with any questions.

LAUNDRY AND LINENS

Laundry is done once a week for our campers and is included in the camp fees. We ask that our campers bring two sets of twin sheets, as our laundry will go out on Thursday and not return until Friday. We will supply a Camp Highlander blanket to be used while at camp. We do recommend that you send old clothes to camp with your child. We have no control over the laundry service, so we ask that you label all items to ensure their return to your camper from our lost and found.

WHAT TO BRING AND NOT TO BRING

A packing list will be included in the Pre-Camp Kit that is sent to you in March, or it may be found on the Camp Highlander website at www.camphighlander.com under the forms section.

Campers should **NOT** bring any food, candy, lighters, water guns, balloons, skateboards, televisions, video games, cell phones, video cameras or similar electronic devices. An MP3 player or walkman that is only capable of playing music may be used during rest hour. Knives, guns, weapons, alcohol, tobacco products, drugs or drug paraphernalia are grounds for dismissal from camp.
